Ancer W. Delashment, Jr. transitioned on January 24, 2022 at his residence in Glenwood, Illinois. He was born on August 24, 1964 in Chicago, Illinois, the oldest son of Lancer Sr. and Bessie Delashment.

Lancer graduated from Morgan Park High School. He also obtained a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Robert Morris University and a Master of Arts degree in Education from Concordia University Chicago. He spent his career working as both an accountant and a teacher. In May 1988, Lance married his beautiful wife Tracie where they celebrated over 34 years together.

Called to the ministry in his youth, in October 1998 Lancer and Tracie founded the Heritage of Life Covenant Church in Hazel Crest, Illinois. He pastored 21 years as a preacher, teacher, musician and songwriter and was later ordained an Apostle in July 2010. Lancer and Tracie spent many years sharing the Word of God through teaching seminars locally and internationally. This fostered healthy relationships within the local church and trained people to operate in both maturity and balance.

Lancer's passion was his insatiable hunger for reading and studying God's Word. As a teenager, he often spent many nights keeping his brother Kermit up late asking him for permission to read one more chapter. Another passion he had was writing worship songs. He would often play his acoustic guitar leading the members of his congregation in worship during church services.

In addition to his mother Bessie, he was preceded in death by a sister, Evelyn. 
















HONEYMOON ORIUS




